no trouble. He worked looking as ever but keeps to himself and

Sept. 1910 At times not so some time and goes to farm's for any day to attend  
to farm. Sings no trouble talking to himself continuously.

Jan 95 So far has proved himself a trustworthy man at the  
farm. Same and has due to work well and joins trouble.

Jan 96 Works steadily, at farm house. Always in good health.  
Sings no trouble whatever. Never complains a lot like boy.

Jan 97 Also not had an illness works steadily. Clean, tidy,

atheromatous. 19th urine today - Color yellow (reddish) Sp. Gr. 1022.  
React Strongly Acid. No Albumen. No Sugar. Urea 3%.

Dec 1 96 Has become quite delirious in abdomen. Taking Purgatives get rid  
of. Also Digitalis atropine. 9th So today tapped and a gal of fluid drawn  
from abdomen. So turned afterwards but was not had any marked  
distress from Dyspnoea. Respiration rate from 20 to 25. Pulse has ranged  
from 70 to 90 usually between 80 and 90. So of had quality irregular and  
sometimes intermittent. 10th Last night Temp reached 100° pulse 100.  
Resp 25. This am Pulse 70 Temp 97 = Resp 24. There is a great out  
of going from tremor.

Jan 1 97 So nearly as large as before being tapped. Pulse is very bad  
quality irregular and at times intermittent. Still taking Stimulants &  
heart tones with the Puls-plexus. Temp has usually been within 2°  
of normal either above or below. Pulse from 70 to 100. Respiration has  
been usually below 25. 13th So very weak - Does not complain. Today  
tapped again and about 1 1/2 gal drawn off. Temp was continued about  
normal. Pulse between 80 and 90. Resp 20 to 25. 15th So coming but large.

Jan 18 97 Died today. Cause Heart Disease. Last night Temp  
rose to 101.5°. Pulse 112 Resp 28. This am Temp 101. Pulse 100 Resp 20.  
He suffered no pain and never complained.
