## **The Rosburg Family**

Within this document, we have eight generations of Rosburg's with birthdates ranging from approximately 1816 to 2005 – a span of nearly 200 years! On the following pages there are 199 "Rosburgs" who represent the offspring of Henry Rosburg, a German from an area of Germany, northwest of Berlin in Mecklenburg and Holstian Provinces in the early 1800s. A map of Germany in 1789 and a modern day one are included for fun. There are also 103 individuals represented who were fortunate enough to marry a "Rosburg" descendant!


His son William Frederick Rosburg (born 1836) married Maria Dorothia Nieland (born 1847) in Germany on October 31, 1863. Ten of their twelve children are shown in the attached photo. They moved to Blairstown, Iowa where Karl Henrich Rosburg was born in 1866. "Apparently" he changed his name in America to Charles Henry Rosburg. He married Eleanora "Ella" Grimm (born 1868) on January 16, 1892. Our ancestors were all farmers and Lutherans. Karl (Charles) and Ella are interned in a Hubbard, Iowa cemetery.


One of their five children, William August Rosburg (born 1903) married Lois Clara Ann Teske (born 1904) on November 15, 1922. William and Lois gave birth to eight children – seven daughters and one son. If it had been seven sons and one daughter, Junior would not be under such pressure to perpetuate the Rosburg name?! These five generations are depicted on a single chart. The fifth generation, the eight children of William and Lois, are depicted on separate charts with their sixth, seventh, and eighth generations.

All of the first four generations of Rosburg ancestors have left us, including from the fifth generation Donald "Bud", Patricia "Pat", and LaVonne. Some of us have also lost treasured children, siblings, and grandchildren. This Rosburg Family Tree and the Reunion will honor them all and cherish their memory with scores of Rosburgs – whatever our names today!






