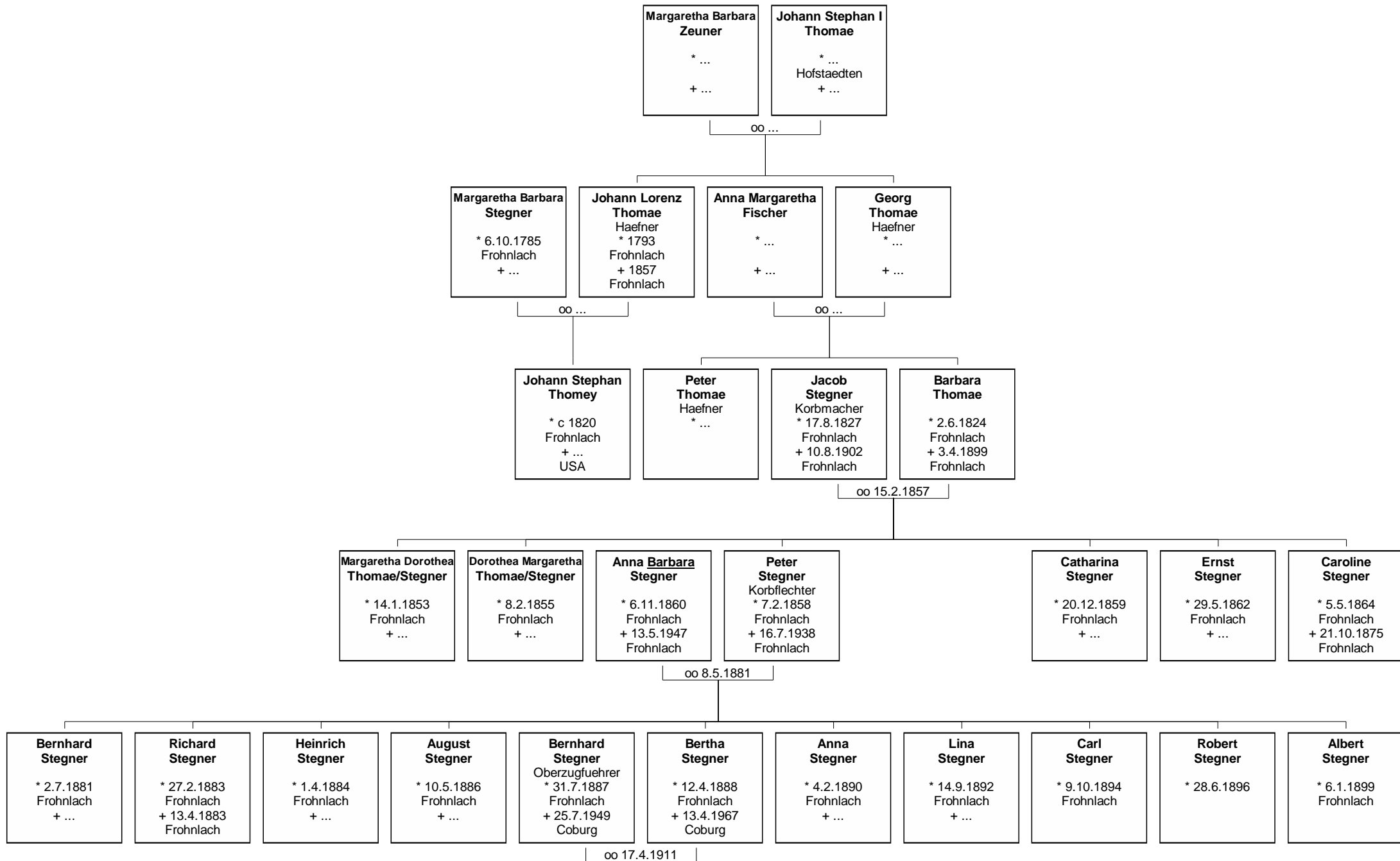

Cause of Death: Senile gangrene of right foot & leg
Burial Place: Section #12 (Koltes Post), Row 5, Grave 14 (Headstone, a contract was filled out for a headstone for Stephen Thomey, the Vermont Marble Company was the maker of the headstone, it was never made. Since Johann is a veteran i filled out the application process so he can have headstone. The headstone reads Stephen Thomey, PVT. CO. H, 68 NY INF, SEP 24 1824, AUG 6, 1887).

Military Service: : Enlisted as Stephen Thomy and as a Private on July 30, 1861, NYC. Enlisted in 68th New York Infantry, Co. H, 3rd Div. on August 1, 1861. Transferred to 82nd Illinois Infantry, Co. E (Jan. 20, 1864 - Mar. 21, 1864). Transferred to 68th NY Inf. March 22, 1864. Discharged Rank: Private. Mustered out of service: August 22, 1864 in Nashville, Tennessee. Company Mustered out: November 30, 1865 in Fort Pulaski, Georgia.

Present or Absent: (Not Stated) Aug. 1861 - Aug. 1862 (Dec. 1861 on duty division, bakery; Jan. 31, 1862 returned to the Company from divison, bakery); Present: Sept. 1862 - Oct. 1862; Absent: Nov. 1862 - Apr. 1863; Present: May 1863 - Oct. 1863; Absent: Nov. 1863 - Mar. 1864 (sick or wounded in hospital); Present: Apr. 1864 - Aug. 1864.

Pension Application - Applied as Stephen Thomey. (Date of Filing, May 1, 1886; claim no. 572.109): Disabled by a wound of left shoulder on the 1st of July 1863 at Gettysburg, Penn. Admitted to the hospital Nov. 7, 1863 with a fever. Admitted to the hospital Nov. 22, 1863 with diarrhea and returned to duty Jan. 26, 1864. Wound of right leg between the knee and ankle on the Nov. 25, 1863 at Mission Ridge, Tenn.
