

Brown Family Cemetery or Cartner Family Cemetery

Civil Township:

Palestine

General Location:

Southeast of Billingsville

Northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 34.

Directions:

From Speed, Missouri, take Route F east, about one mile to the first crossroads; turn left (north) on gravel road and go about 1 ½ miles; the Grissum land is on the left (west) side of the road. Ask for the location of the cemetery.

Atlas Survey:

1877 Land Atlas – a cemetery symbol on Isaac Brown land. His land occupied practically the eastern half of section 34 and the western half of section 35.

1915 Land Atlas – no cemetery symbol on land in the names of T. Cartner, R. A. Cartner, and Theo Cartner.

1978 Plat Book – no cemetery symbol on the land in the names of John Whitehurse, Cartner and Carey.

1991 Plat Book – no cemetery symbol on land in the name of John Whitehurse or Grissum Farms.

History:

Originally located immediately south and adjacent to the residence of Isaac Brown home-place. The entries for this cemetery were taken from family records provided by Laura Gail Schler, Mrs. Frances Douth Smith and Jim Thoma. There are probably other members of the Brown family and possibly members of the Stegner family buried in this cemetery.

Stegner	Margaret Ellen née Brown; born 15 Sep 1838 in Palestine Township, Cooper County, Missouri; died 25 Feb 1914 In Palestine Township, Cooper County, Missouri; wife of John Nicholas Stegner; married 09 Mar 1865 in Clarks Fork Township, Cooper County, Missouri; daughter of James Isaac and Margaret Ellen Brown.
Stegner	Marion Irvin; born 18 Feb 1876 in Palestine Township, Cooper County, Missouri; died 25 Jul 1947 in Sate Hospital #1, Fulton, Callaway County, Missouri; son of John Nicholas and Margaret Ellen née Brown Stegner; husband of Clara Belle Twyman (buried Syracuse, Missouri); married 29 Dec 1921 in Tipton, Moniteau County, Missouri; was twice married one wife is buried in Syracuse, Missouri and the other near Blackwater, Missouri
Stegner	Mary Jane; born 31 Jan 1866 in Palestine Township, Cooper County, Missouri; died 14 Oct 1944 in St. Joseph Hospital, Boonville, Cooper County, Missouri; never married; daughter of John Nicholas and Margaret Ellen née Brown Stegner; on death certificate name is given as Mollie Ann; died as a result from a fractured right hip.
