History:

"At one time there was a small graveyard located approximately in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 14, T-48-N; R-18-W (or about 18 1/4 miles south of Boonville on Highway #5 and then west off the road. The site is now a plowed field and has been for many years. Three tombstones removed from this site now rest against the fence around the house owned by Ernest Ekstam (commonly referred to as "The Doc Nelson Place"). Whether there were other graves is not known.

The Carr Family Cemetery was collected by Mr. Eugene A. Cordry on September 21, 1970 and is updated through December 1984

Updated:

January 31, 2009 with 4 entries for this cemetery.

Carr	Elizabeth B.; consort of Mead Carr; born 03 Jan 1803; died 01 Apr 1859; aged 59 years, 2 months, 28 days; Note it would appear that Elizabeth Carr was 56 not 59 years old at her death. Several rubbings were made and the birth and death dates are correct.
Carr	Mead; born 22 Feb 1806; died 09 Mar 1855; aged 49 years, 18 days
Cherry	W.; no dates; originally buried in the Carr Family Cemetery; later buried outside what is now Bethlehem Church Cemetery; between the road and fence; unmarked
Martin	Fannie A.; daughter of W. W. and C. M. Martin; died 06 Sep 1863; aged 3 years, 7 months, 12 days
