## History:

### History of the Salt Fork Cemetery Club

When Mrs. McGuire wrote the history of the Salt Fork Church in 1920, the present Salt Fork Cemetery Club had been organized only a short time. A club was organized in 1907 with Mrs. McGuire as president; Miss Emma M. Harvey as secretary; Miss Clara Harvey as treasurer. This organization functioned for only a short time. In 1919, on August 23rd, the present club was organized with Mrs. John Baker, presiding as

chairman. The following officers were elected: Mrs. W. T. Asbury, president; Mrs. Uncas McGuire, secretary-treasurer; Mrs. Oscar Younger, corresponding secretary; Mrs. Sarah Bruce, chaplain. However, Mrs. Bruce asked to be excused and was replaced by Mrs. R. R. Cunningham at the next meeting. Of the officers, Mrs. R. R. Cunningham and Mrs. McGuire gave long and faithful service until their recent deaths, each serving a few months over twenty years in the office to which they were elected in 1919. Mrs. Oscar Younger has served as secretary-treasurer since Mrs. McGuire's death and has cheerfully faced the responsibility of keeping accurate records, selling lots, and carrying on the many other duties of her position.

Since the death of Mrs. Cunningham, Mrs. Bud Griffith has served as chaplain with Mrs. John Martin as assistant chaplain. Both have attended regularly and helped the club in many ways additional to performing their duties as chaplain.

Mrs. W. T. Asbury, the first president of the club, served for two years, and although now living in Denver, Colorado sends her dues and donations regularly and is interested in seeing the club continue its good work. Following Mrs. Asbury, Mrs. Walter Shouse served as president in 1921 and again in 1924. Mrs. Elmer Alfrey served in 1922. The year of 1923, Mrs. Marion R. (Mary) Gillespie was elected president and served faithfully all but three years for 1923 until her death in 1945. In 1926, Mrs. Matt Riley was elected president and served for two years. Mrs. Gillespie was serving here twentieth year when death called her. She was tireless in her efforts to keep the club alive and mindful of its purpose. Since her death, Mrs. C. W. Racy who had been vice-president a number of years and has been an ardent worker and cheerful helper in the club since its organization, served as president until Mrs. Clara Harvey Gillespie was elected in 1946 and has served since that time, with Mrs. Clay Griffith serving as vice-president.

The present officers deserve our praise and support as they accept offices that increase in responsibility as the membership becomes smaller and more widespread. Not only do the capable and efficient officers of the club deserve praise, but also the handful of loyal members who remain.

There are about seventy-five (75) active and honorary paid up members listed as charter members in 1919. Of these, many have passed away or moved to a distance and now only a small group remains to carry on although a larger number are still interested and return to home-comings and send donations.

The club when organized had a big task before it, but, after the many expenses of the first year in cleaning off the cemetery, cutting away brush, leveling graves, sowing grass, putting up a fence, and straightening stones, the club was still able to report a balance of \$23.36 at the end of the first year. Since that first year, they have continued each year to improve the grounds, and the church after it was purchased, painted and repaired in 1921. A drive-way has been made and chatted, a gate and arch erected at the entrance, the church insured, and the grounds cleaned and mowed each spring and summer until Salt Fork has become one of the most beautiful resting places in rural Missouri. Although it has no curving roadways lined with evergreens and no patterned flower beds such as you might find in more populated areas, yet there is a quaint, quiet beauty about the wide-spreading trees and scattered flowers planted by loving hands, that make it a spot dear to us all.

All this has not been without effort and toil, however. Each year in the spring, the club (men and women) meet for an all-day meeting and rake, cut, and clean off the grounds, killing poison ivy and making repairs on the church if necessary.

It is very interesting to note the various ways the club has raised money to carry on its work. Annually, they have held a bazaar and dinner which in the first year netted \$87.90 and in the second year, \$106.11. They have had ice cream socials, served sale dinners, put on plays, held sock and apron socials, hen socials, parcel post drawings, old fiddler's contests, and employed various other schemes for securing funds.

By November 1927, they had accumulated a surplus of funds which they voted to use to start a sinking fund. It is their hope to build up this fund so that the interest on same may eventually serve as a security for continuation of the upkeep of the grounds. By 1930, the fund had climbed to \$409.60. Each year, a sum has been added until now, twenty years since the start of the fund the club can report bonds purchased in 1943 with maturity value of \$1000.00 and \$300.00 on time deposit. In November 1948, an active member of the club presented the club with a bond that will have a maturity value of \$100.00; making a total of bonds owned by the club, \$1100.00 at maturity.

The annual collection at home-comings has also gone toward the upkeep of the cemetery. In looking back at the various home-comings, it is interesting to note the wide variation in collections from \$7.96 in 1947; the lowest recorded, to \$91.70 in 1945 the highest recorded collection.

In 1942, the club celebrated the one-hundredth (100) anniversary of the church at its annual home-coming. A program was arranged for both morning and afternoon and people from far and near came with baskets over-flowing to see old friends and visit the graves of loved ones.

May the spirit of friendliness and fellowship continue to abide with our home-comings and may the words of our beloved secretary-treasurer who lies at rest in Salt Fork Cemetery be a challenge to us to carry on the work to which she gave such long and untiring service, taken from the secretary's report of April 28, 1924, she wrote these words, "The club wished to thank those who helped and those who didn't help, we always things should have done so."

In the cemetery, the oldest date of death recorded upon a stone is 1851. However, the very first bodies were not placed in the cemetery itself but were buried in an adjoining pasture where most of them remain today.

On August 23, 1919, Salt Fork Cemetery Club was organized for the purpose of improving and caring for the sadly neglected cemetery. The cemetery consists of four acres and the club has transformed the spot from a wilderness into one of the most beautiful of country cemeteries. The graves were leveled and neat markers placed at unknown graves. The entrance is marked by an arch, and leading from that is a chat driveway with flowers arranged on either side. Trees, abundant and beautiful, are profusely scattered about the parking grounds as well as around the building itself. The abandoned church and grounds now belong to the Cemetery Club, having been purchased in October 1921, from the New Lebanon Presbytery for (\$40) forty dollars.

Recorded by Mr. Harold Holder; list supplied to association by Mrs. Cornine. Mr. Holder said there were eleven (11) unmarked graves, across the fence in a pasture; no record of who was buried there.

There is a metal marker on a pipe at the corn of the McCorkle burial lots, by the main drive. It says, "American Presbyterian and Reformed Historical Site #12, Registered by the Presbyterian Historical Society, Philadelphia, PA."

This list is sorted alphabetically. Later entries from obituaries and are presumed to be buried in the new section. Other entries are from Kathy Peuster and are corrections or additions for the Gash, Cunningham, Jackson, Wolford, Marshall, and Griffith families. Other additions are from Ann Martin Bellamy on the Caton, Martin, McGuire, and Taylor families; while the latest additions (and most detailed) are from Marilyn Scott. In January of 1995, he was honored for having given 50 years of service to John Deere, and continued working until November, when he was diagnosed with cancer. In 1972, Warren and Jo bought their farm near Nelson, fulfilling his lifelong dream. He took great pride in farming and raising cattle. He enjoyed his grandchildren, encouraging them to love the farm and appreciate the rural environment. He was proud of his family.
