History:

Section adjoining churchyard of St. John's United Church of Christ at Billingsville, Missouri. This cemetery was abandoned in order to extend an addition onto the church building. The markers were moved to the new cemetery across the road. Many years ago the markers from the Stegner Family Cemetery on the land of Feodor Stegner were moved to this cemetery. They were stacked on the ground at the edge of the cemetery near a small building, until this burial place was abandoned.

Hoflander	Fannie Pauline; born 29 Mar 1878; died 21 Jul 1898; only daughter of Paul and Mary nee' Quint Hoflander
Hoflander	Henry Christian; born 07 Dec 1882; died 28 Feb 1961; son of Paul and Maria E. "Mary" nee Quint Hoflander; store keeper at Billingsville for many years
Hoflander	John Ernst; Stone broken; "Zu Grosgrarnstadt, Sachsen-Coburg, Germany; died 24 Aug 1879; Note this corresponds to data on John Ernst Hoflander, husband of Kunigunda nee' Stegner Hoflander; son of Heinrich Hoflander, a miller who resided in London, England for many years and married Kunigunde Ludwig; John Ernst Hoflander arrived at Boonville, Missouri on 26 Feb 1854
Hoflander	Kunigunda nee' Stegner; born 10 Feb 1806 in Frohnlach, Sachsen-Coburg, Germany; died 19 Mar 1891
Hoflander	Maria E. "Mary" nee' Quint; born 15 Jan 1847 in Prussia, Germany; died 15 Jan 1932; came to America in 1854; daughter of Henry and Elizabeth nee' Walje Quint; wife of Paul Hoflander
Hoflander	Paul; born 26 Oct 1838 in Germany; died 18 Jan 1961; son of John Ernst and Kunigunda nee'

	Stegner Hoflander of Germany; husband of Maria E. "Mary" nee Quint Hoflander of Clear Creek, Missouri
Kirsch	Friedrich Herman; born 20 Mar 1844; died (stone broken); aged 30 years, 4 months, and days
Osten	Anna Marie nee' Bosold; "Mother"; born 06 Feb 1832 in Germany; died 14 Nov 1918 in Boonville Township, Cooper County, Missouri; buried 16 Nov 1918; daughter of Peter Bosold; wife of H. M. Christian Osten; Most information from death certificate, this is stone next to Christian Osten
Osten	H. M. Christian; born 26 Feb 1825 in Brunswick, Germany; died 17 May 1898
Rentschler	Barbara; born 02 Sep 1836; died 26 May 1910; wife of John Rentschler
Rentschler	David; died 17 Jul 1911; aged 73 years; no marker
Rentschler	Elizabeth Marie; born 07 Feb 1872; died 13 Nov 1902; daughter of John and Barharad Rentschler
Rentschler	John; born 09 Jul 1828; died 12 mar 1907; husband of Barbara Rentschler
Runyon	Frances Marie; born Nov 1904; died 01 Mar 1905; daughter of G. A. and Laura Runyon
Schubert	Gottlieb, Mrs.; no maker; no dates; according to Cooper County Missouri history they came to America in 1861; both are deceased many years are interred in the cemetery at Billingsville, Missouri
Schubert	Gottlieb; no maker; no dates; probably buried here
Shermer	Frederick W.; born 05 Nov 1882; died 30 Dec 1891; Note: Possibly another grave here: "Grandma Shermer" who prepared and sold patented medicine known as "Grandma Shermer's Remedy". Neighbors of hers in Speed, at the time of her death verify her burial here. No marker. She died in the early part of the 20th century.
Stegner	Ada V.; born 24 Nov 1885; died 15 Nov 1891; daughter of George John and Theresa nee' Ritzhaupt Stegner, first wife
Stegner	Johann Georg; born 15 Oct 1851 in America; died 09 Mar 1854; infant son of John Peter and Margaretha Barbara nee' Hertha Stegner
Stegner	John Paul; died 03 Mar 1876; aged 68 years; wife of Katherine Stegner
Stegner	John Peter; born 09 Apr 1812 in Frohnlach, Sachsen-Coburg, Germany; died 12 Jan 1878; this marker brought from old family burial ground on Stegner homestead; other pieces of markers; badly broken and two other person brought here also as follows;
Stegner	Katherine; died 30 Jan 1898; aged 88 years; wife of John Paul Stegner; charter member of the church
Stegner	Margaretha Barbara nee' Hertha; wife of John Peter Stegner; born 15 Apr 1817; died 06 Jan 1892; native of Germany
Stegner	Minnie "Birdie"; born 21 May 1886; died 08 Mar 1887; daughter of George John and Katherine nee' Schreck Stegner, second wife
Torbeck	Emilie Fredericke; born 12 May or Mar 1861; died 09 ??? 1888 ?; daughter of Wilhelm ? and Sophia ? Trobeck
Torbeck	Marie Charlotte; born 28 Jul 1807; died 27 Sep 18?? In ?burg, Missouri; rubbed but illegible
Torbeck	Sofia M. nee' Laars; born 07 Nov 1839 in Strom, Kerdorf, Mecklenburg, Schwerin, Germany; died 14 Jun 1927 at Boonville, Missouri
Torbeck	Wilhelm H.; born 29 Apr 1841 in Diephalz, Konigreich, Hanover, Germany; died 08 Aug 1939; son of Rudoph and Sophia Torbeck; husband of Sofia nee' Loss ? Torbeck; married 10 Aug 1866; came to America in 1882
Willig	August; born 03 Oct 1809; died 02 ? Feb 1897; husband of Eustne F. Willig
Willig	Eustne ? F.; born 25 Jun 1802; died 13 Aug 1894; wife of August Willig
